Subject to the prevailing Covid-19 constraints we will be running the 76th annual [Fareham Music Festival](#) between Friday 29th April and Sunday 1st May 2022 at West Hill Park School in Titchfield. If you have not visited us before I would like to take this opportunity of explaining what we do and inviting you to enter students to the festival.

Fareham Music Festival (like the other 300+ Festivals affiliated to the [British and International Federation of Festivals for Music, Dance & Speech](#)) is a charitable organisation run entirely by volunteers. The Federation is dedicated to providing a platform for people of all ages interested in the performing arts. We organise a weekend of music-making in Fareham with the benefit of constructive criticism from experienced adjudicators. Despite its competitive nature, we pride ourselves on creating a friendly atmosphere for all our visitors. Our adjudicators for 2022 will be Angela Rowley (for choral & vocal) and Roy Robinson (for piano & instrumental).

The Festival Committee seeks to work in partnership with parents, guardians and teachers and endeavours to provide, as far as is practicable, a safe and secure environment for all participants. If you are entering competitors who are children or vulnerable adults, please draw the attention of their parents/guardians/carers to our Safeguarding Policy (in the Syllabus and on our [website](#)), and remind them that they are responsible for the safety of their children and should accompany and supervise them throughout the Festival.

Current positions vacant at present are: -

1. Hon. Secretary - Taking committee meeting minutes (typically four per annum) and acting as a general point of contact, referring the matter on as necessary
2. Safeguarding officer - Ensuring that procedures are in place to protect vulnerable people. These are currently in place and only need checking on an annual basis to ensure all procedures remain valid. Also, ensuring DBS checks are undertaken if required.

We also need help from volunteers during the weekend of the Festival to act as stewards in various places, e.g., taking admission fees at the door, providing support to the adjudicators, and assisting at the certificate desks.
